CART REGULATIONS WASTE COLLECTION

When wheeled containers are placed in your area, all Garbage and containerized trash will be collected at curbside on the collection day shown above. Residents are requested to place all garbage in wheeled containers, which must be rolled to the curb on your regular collection day for this route.

NOTE THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Place wheeled cart at curbside by 7:30 a.m. on your regular collection day.
- 2. Wheeled cart should be removed form curbside as soon as possible on the day of collection, but no later than 7:00 p.m.
- 3. Wheeled cart lids must be kept closed at all times and carts must be kept clean to comply with health and sanitation requirements.
- 4. The cart remains the property of the Town of White Pine and must not be painted, abused, mutilated, altered or modified in any manner.
- 5. This cart is issued to this address and must not be removed from the premises. If a dwelling is to be vacated, the outgoing resident must notify the Department of Public Works, 674-2556.
- 6. ONLY WASTE IN CANS WILL BE PICKED UP
- 7. The following items must not be placed in the cart: Paints, gasoline, solvents, hot ashes, ferrous metals not normally found in household garbage.
- Please record the serial number of your cart. If your cart is stolen, you should notify the Department of Public Works, 674-2556. Failure to notify may result in delay and expense to the Town and may deny replacement of your cart.

THE TOWN WILL DELIVER THE CART AND PLACE THE CART WHERE THE TOWN PREFERS IT BE PLACED ON THE REGULAR COLLECTION DAY. ALTERNATE LOCATIONS FOR COLLECTION OF THE CART MAY BE ARRANGED WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

IF YOU FAIL TO HAVE THE WHEELED CART AT STREETSIDE AT THE TIME THE SANITATION TRUCK ARRIVES, THIS WILL INDICATE TO US THAT NO SERVICE IS NEEDED, AND THE CART WILL BE SERVICED ON THE NEXT REGULAR COLLECTION DAY.

THE FOLLOWING HOLIDAYS WILL BE OBSERVED AS HOLIDAYS FOR TOWN OF WHITE PINE EMPLOYEES:
