

Town of White Pine Council Meeting Minutes

August 4, 2020

Mayor Warren called the meeting to order with all council members present. Attorney Churchwell was present also.

On a motion from Mrs. Strom, second from Mr. Dukes, the minutes from the July 7, 2020 meeting were unanimously approved.

On a motion from Mr. Taylor, second from Mrs. Strom, Whitney Woods was unanimously appointed to serve the remainder of Henry Taylor's seat on the Planning Commission.

On a motion from Mr. Stump, second from Mr. Dukes, Resolution #20-2, authorizing the town to participate in the Safety Partners Grant, was unanimously approved.

On a motion from Mrs. Strom, second from Mr. Dukes, it was unanimously voted to proclaim September 2020 as White Pine History Month. Displays will be in the window of 1625 Main Street for citizens to view.

On a motion from Mrs. Strom, second by Mr. Dukes, it was unanimously decided to allow White Pine School to use the football field for Physical Education classes and recess for the 2020-21 school year.

Chief Cotter gave the board written reports of the police and fire department.

In Planning Commission news, Mr. Taylor reported the letter of credit for Whispering Pines subdivision was denied to lower the amount. Jefferson Park was granted a rezoning of the property on Main Street from R-1 to R-2. The ordinance for the rezoning will be presented at the September meeting.


Under water and sewer news, Mr. Allsup reported that the wastewater plant excavation should be completed by the middle of next week.

Under new business, Jeremiah Lettermen from the White Pine Athletic Club asked if they could use the facilities and follow the same guidelines as the school. On a motion from Mrs. Strom, second by Mr. Marshall, it was agreed for them to use and to provide a schedule of the games.

The East Tennessee Horseshoe Association also asked about using the pits for tournaments and practice. On a motion from Mr. Dukes, second from Mrs. Strom, it was unanimously approved to allow the use of the horseshoe pits.

On a motion from Mr. Dukes, second from Mr. Marshall, it was unanimously voted to pay bills.

On a motion from Mr. Dukes, second from Mr. Stump, it was unanimously voted to adjourn at 7:22 pm.
