

Town Council Meeting July 5, 2022

Mayor Taylor called the meeting to order with all council members present except Mr. Stump. Attorney Drinnon was present also.

There were no comments or communication from citizens or property owners.

On a motion from Mr. Dukes, second from Mrs. Strom, the minutes of the June 7, 2022 meeting were unanimously approved.

On a motion from Mr. Dukes, second from Mr. Marshall, the minutes of the June 21, 2022 meeting were unanimously approved.

On a motion from Mr. Dukes, second from Mr. Marshall, the minutes of the June 21, 2022 public hearing were unanimously approved.

On a motion from Mr. Marshall, second from Mrs. Strom, Ordinance #6-22, eliminating comp time passed unanimously in a roll call vote on first reading.

Police and fire reports were given to the board. Chief Cotter mentioned that the new brush truck had come in.

Planning Commission, recreation and water and sewer had no reports to give.

Mr. Rednour reported that large item pick up was done that day and everyone had a lot out.

Financial reports were given to the board for Revenue's through June.

Mr. Dukes reported on Pine fest. A meeting was held on June 28th and items discussed were the history committee and what they are planning to do that day. Several sponsors have been secured and twenty-three booths have turned in applications. Lost Creek Band and Grits will be performing and the tent rental is on with Volunteer Party Rentals. A jeep show was discussed but not sure that will happen. Discussion is still going on for an after party. The group will meet again on July 12th.
